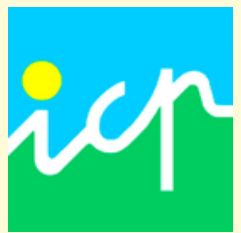




OUR SCHOOL

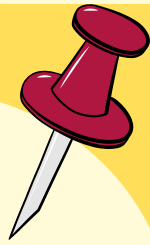


"G. Pascoli" is one of the most reputed public schools located in Sesto San Giovanni (near Milan). It includes the following

Outside our school we have a big playground.

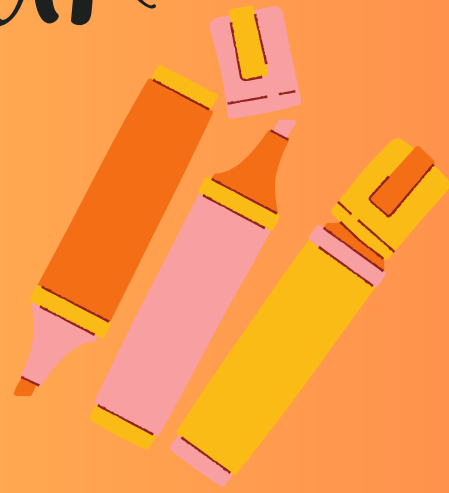


The playground is used for gym activities and as a gathering point for emergencies.

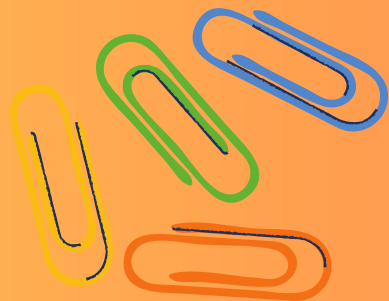
Our school is beautiful!!!



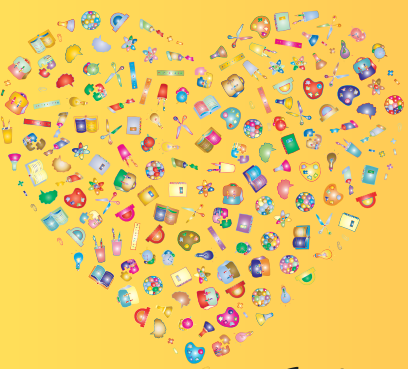
PEOPLE IN OUR SCHOOL



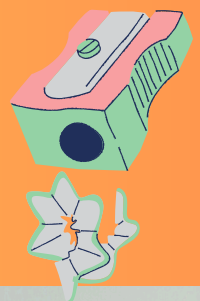
This is our headmaster; her name is Sara Di Nunzio. She is very strict, resolute and on top of things.
